This class `aclbrief` is an extension of the NTG class `brief` made by Victor Eijkhout. You should consult `briefdoc.tex` for additional information about the use of options not described in the current text.

The class `aclbrief` provides a letterhead. Therefore you should not use the `\maakbriefhoofd{ }{ }` command of the `brief` document class.

The following options can be used to modify the lay-out:

`european` Letter from the European Chapter of the ACL.

`northamerican` Letter from the North American Chapter of the ACL.

`color` Logo will be printed in red.

**language options** There are language options for Dutch, English, German, and French. This option influences short captions such as date. Dutch is the default.

Before the `\begin{document}` command you should set you name and address with the `\myaddress{ }` command.

Make sure to provide a date. Otherwise,  $\text{\LaTeX}$  will provide it for you, and the date will change with the day the document is processed.

Don't forget to set numbers in `\num{ }`, like `1234567890`, or you'll get table numbers like `1234567890`, which are too large within running text.
