This document serves both as a demonstration and as documentation for the L^AT_EX 2_ε document class `aibrief`. This document class is to be used by anyone who is writing official letters in their function as staff members of the *Alfa-Informatica* department.

This class `aibrief` is an extension of the NTG class `brief` made by Victor Eijkhout. You should consult `briefdoc.tex` for additional information about the use of options not described in the current text.



The class `aibrief` provides a letterhead with the official RuG escutcheon and logo. Name and address information of the *Alfa-Informatica* department are provided. Therefore you should not use the `\maakbriefhoofd{ }{ }` command of the `brief` document class.

The following options can be used to modify the lay-out:

language options There are language options for Dutch, English, German, and French. This option influences short captions such as date, and translations for department name and country. Dutch is the default.

kleur Escutcheon and logo will be printed in dark blue.

clcg Use department name *Center for Language and Cognition Groningen*.

cmc Use department name *Computer-Mediated Communication*, and add CMC logo.

gheta With this option the department will be named as *GHETA: Groningen Historical Electronic Text Archive*, instead of *Alfa-Informatica*. Defaults for `\telefoon{ }` and `\email{ }` will be George Welling's. The default language will be US-English.

Two header commands complement the default address information:

`\telefoon{ }` Specify the four digit telephone number of your office. If this option is omitted, the secretary phone number will be used.
