language options There are language options for Dutch, English, German, and French. This option influences short captions such as date, and translations for letterhead and country. Dutch is the default.

kleur Letterhead will be printed in red.

clcg Use department name CLCG.

cl Use department name computational linguistics.

Two header commands complement the default address information:

\telefoon{} Specify the four digit telephone number of your office. If this option is omitted, the secretary phone number will be used. \email{} This command is also optional.

Make sure to provide a date. Otherwise, LATEX will provide it for you, and the date will change with the day the document is processed.
